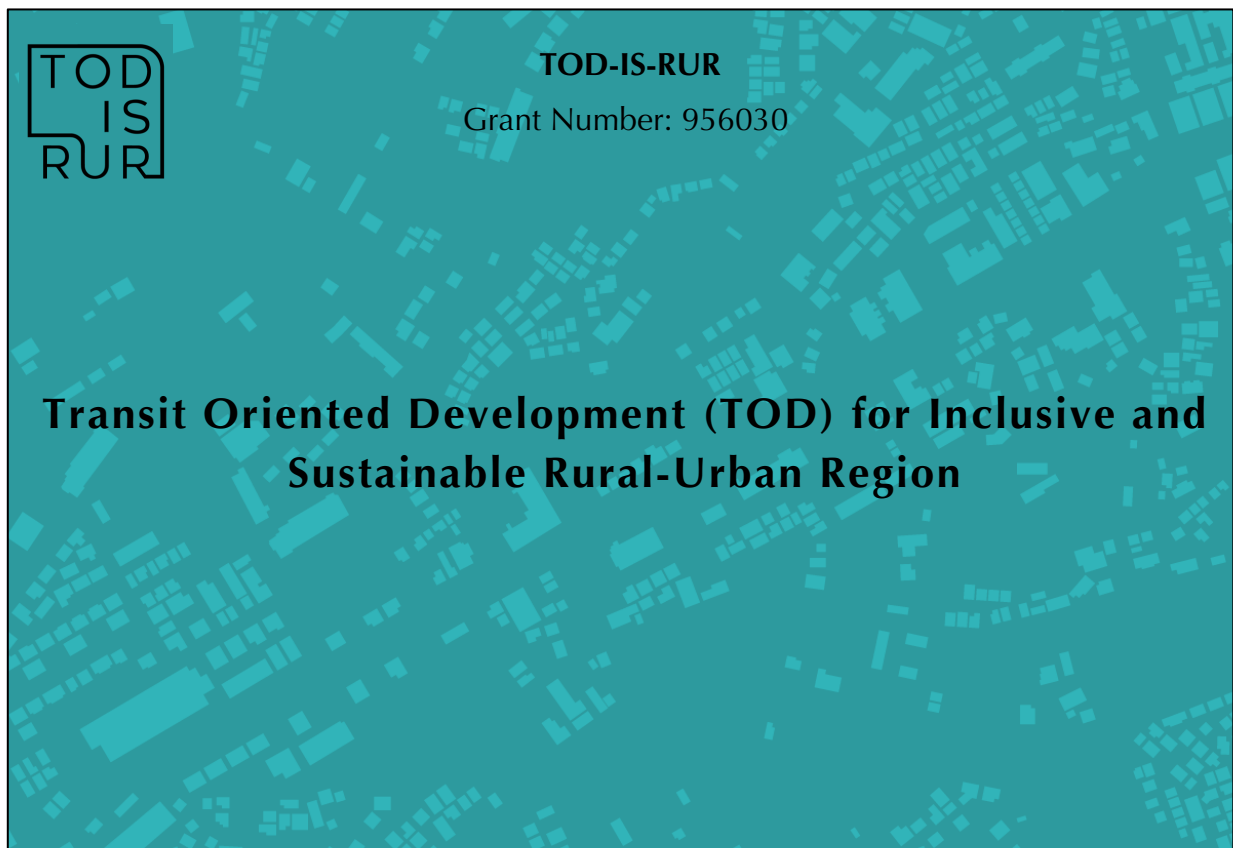

Aims and program description

Following up the evaluation of the ‘Kick off meeting and initial training days’ taking place online over October and November, we will organize extra training in Antwerp focusing on research design and the individual research projects of the ESRs.

An essential part of the TOD-IS-RUR training is the ESRs’ feedback on session organization and its training materials. The TOD-IS-RUR network-wide events are evaluated by ESRs, identifying strengths, weaknesses, and gaps in training, to optimize the future training provision, tailored and adapted to the needs of the ESRs and the project. In the evaluation of the initial training days, an explicit need for more training was forwarded on (1) research design, (2) individual ESR projects as well as on (3) the relation between common network goals and the individual ESR-projects.

The program will be structured around four types of training sessions:

1) Lecture session: setting up a research design, comparative research/methods, and the relation between theory and empirics, respectively by Caroline Gallez (Uni Eiffel), Nathalie Roseau (ENPC), and Jonathan Metzger (KTH).

2) Thesis sessions: centering on the individual ESR-projects, with an interactive group discussion on research questions and methodologies. Three sessions are planned in which 3 to 4 ESRs present their work. Each presentation is coupled to a group discussion, chaired by at least 2 supervisors.

3) ESR sessions: discussing common training and scientific goals, organized by the ESRs.

4) Wrap-up session, with Luca Bertolini (UvA), Thomas Vanoutrive and Greet De Block (UAntwerpen). We will wrap up the thesis sessions with a brainstorm mapping relations between projects and grouping projects. ESRs and supervisors will start drafting more specific common goals in relation to ESR projects.

Outcomes

By the end of training week, ESRs will be able to:

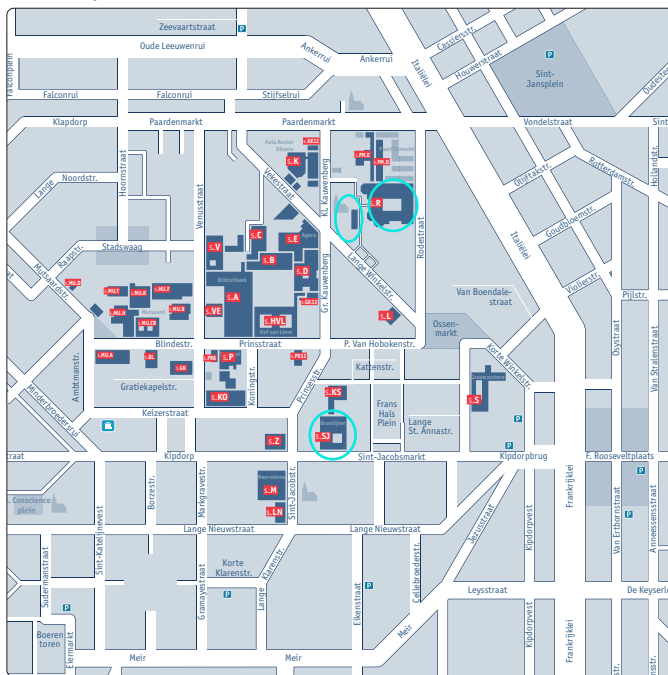
- Understand different stages in research design
- Present the key concept/problem in the research project
- Reflect about their own research questions and framework
- Reflect on the shared research problem and conceptual approaches that guide all individual PhD projects and undergird the scientific and societal challenge of TOD-IS-RUR.
- Engage in joint discussion and share ideas

We will organize the workshop in Antwerp confirm current national and University regulations. As some ESRs might not be able to travel, we will set up the meeting in a hybrid format, enabling online participation.
